

Male Grooming

Hair

A fresh, neat haircut is a must at Kings Dominion. Hair must be natural, neatly trimmed and clean at all times. Styling should be tapered at the sides and back so the lower one-half of the ear is visible and the back is no longer than the top of the collar of a normal dress shirt. Faddish, extreme hairstyles, including (but not limited to) multi-color or unnatural hair colors, sculptured hair, tails, braids, ponytails, dreadlocks, partially shaved heads and spikes are not permitted. Shaved patterns are not permitted. Sideburns may not extend below the earlobe or widen out.



Facial Hair

Volunteers should be clean shaven daily. Beards and goatees are not permitted. However, a neatly-groomed mustache that does not extend below or beyond the corners of the mouth or below the upper lip is permitted.

Tattoos

Tattoos are not permitted to be visible to our guests. Cosmetic make-up, or bandages, should be used to conceal visible tattoos. Tattoos on the face, neck, hands and head are prohibited. Volunteers with tattoos in these locations are not permitted to volunteer at Kings Dominion.

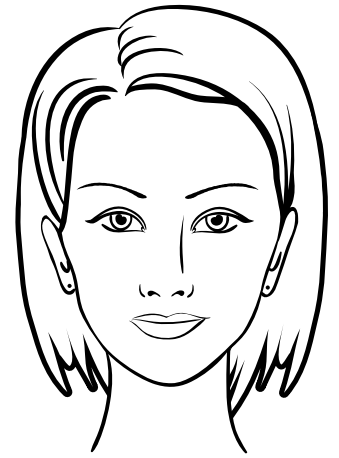
Jewelry

Conservative personal jewelry such as a watch and/or one ring per hand are acceptable. However, heavy, large beaded, or long, dangling necklaces, fabric/fiber jewelry, as well as any body piercing, including an earring, are not in keeping with the Kings Dominion image and, therefore, are not permitted. Adhesive bandages may not be used to cover up piercings. Gauging of the ears is prohibited. Volunteers who have gauged ears are not permitted to volunteer at Kings Dominion.

Female Grooming

Hair

Hair must be natural, clean, well-groomed and simply arranged. Faddish, extreme hairstyles, including (but not limited to) multi-color or unnatural colors, sculptured hair, tails, partially shaved heads and dreadlocks are not permitted. Shaved patterns are not permitted. Those who prefer long hair should take special care so that it will not fall forward or over the face while performing normal job duties, creating a safety hazard.



Make-Up

Volunteers should emphasize the natural look. Nails should be no greater than 1/4" in length beyond fingertips, and if polished, only with one solid color and no additional adornment. Either clear or natural colored nail polishes as well as any polishes which are complimentary to a persons skin color are permitted. In addition, conservative shades of red and pink are also acceptable. Volunteers should also be discreet in the use of cosmetics and perfume.

Tattoos

Tattoos are not permitted to be visible to our guests. Cosmetic make-up, or bandages, should be used to conceal visible tattoos. Tattoos on the face, neck, hands and head are prohibited. Volunteers with tattoos in these locations are not permitted to volunteer at Kings Dominion.

Jewelry

Conservative personal jewelry such as a watch, one ring per hand and no more than two earrings in each lower earlobe is acceptable. Heavy and/or beaded necklaces, dangling bracelets, fabric/fiber jewelry, as well as any body piercing (with the exception of two earrings per lower earlobe) are not in keeping with the Kings Dominion image and are therefore not permitted. Adhesive bandages may not be used to cover up piercings. Gauging of the ears is prohibited. Volunteers who have gauged ears are not permitted to volunteer at Kings Dominion.

Dress Guidelines

Volunteers should report to work in a white shirt, khaki shorts or khaki pants, and lowcut white tennis shoes. Cut-off shorts, and cargo pants and shorts are not permitted. Shirts are to be solid white with no logos or writing. Fundraising groups may wear a shirt listing their organizations name, provided it is a solid color and all members of the group have the appropriate shirt. Organizational Shirts must be approved, by the Kings Dominion Fundraising coordinator, prior to the volunteer date.

Please check the weather. If the weather is cool, volunteers may wear a jacket or sweatshirt with your organizational logo. No other jackets or sweatshirts will be permitted.

In most of our volunteer positions a hat is required to be worn. Fundraisers will wear the Kings Dominion hat provided for them. No other hats may be worn.

Kings Dominion will not make exceptions to our Grooming and Dress code policy. Group members who arrive at the park, but do not meet these guidelines, will not be permitted to participate in the program.
